

CAN SPARE BATTERIES BE CARRIED BY AIR?



Power banks are not permitted in checked baggage.



Power banks must not be stored in the overhead compartments.



Each power bank must not exceed



100 Wh

Power banks exceeding 100 Wh but not exceeding 160 Wh require prior approval from the air operator or flight operator.



Each passenger may carry no more than two power banks.



Charging a power bank from any power source on board the aircraft is not permitted.



Using a power bank to charge a mobile phone or any other electronic device on board the aircraft is not permitted



Power banks must be carried in carry-on baggage only.



Power banks should be kept in the seat pocket, under the seat in front of you, carried with you throughout the journey, or stored in an area designated by the airline.



Power banks with no indicated capacity, or whose capacity cannot be verified, are **not permitted on board**.



Power banks must be protected against short circuit when not in use by:



keeping them in original packaging

or



placing each power bank separately in a plastic bag or protective pouch
